Eligibility Criteria-LL.B.

Age Limit- 21 years and must not be more than 42 years. (For SC/ST/OBC 5 years relaxation)

### PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

The examination shall be conducted in three stages namely-

1. Preliminary Examination
2. Main Examination
3. Viva-Voce

It shall consist of 125 questions and each question shall carry 04 marks. The objective type multiple-choice question for the Preliminary Examination shall be from the syllabus for the Main Examination.
